

JANUARY 12, 2017

TOWN BOARD MEETING

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees of Caseyville Township was called to order at 7 p.m. by Supervisor Canty who directed Clerk Jacknewitz to call the roll, and upon roll call the following members answered present: Trustees Chrismore, Lemansky, and Donovan; absent Moody. Also present John Waldron, highway commissioner, Joe Steinhauer, security, John Wilson, and Mark Blackburn.

Supervisor Canty directed Clerk Jacknewitz to read the minutes of the previous meeting. A motion was made by Mr. Donovan, second by Mr. Lemansky to dispense with the reading of the minutes, and motion carried.

The following bills were approved for payment upon a motion by Mr. Donovan, second by Mr. Chrismore, and motion carried. Bills totaled as follows:

On November 12, 2015, the Fairview Heights Police Department initiated an investigation (15-04532) per the request of Caseyville Township Trustee Richard Donovan and Caseyville Township Clerk David Jacknewitz. Once concluding our investigation, the case was then presented to the office of St. Clair County State's Attorney Brendan Kelly for review. On January 5, 2017, the Fairview Heights Police Department received correspondence from the St. Clair County State's Attorney's Office advising that after reviewing all of the case reports, they have "declined" to prosecute in the above noted incident.

This case is now considered "closed" within the Fairview Heights Police Department.
