

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees of Caseyville Township was called to order at 7 p.m. by Supervisor Donovan who directed Clerk Jacknewitz to call the roll, and upon roll call the following members answered present: Trustees Lemansky, Gough, Green, and Wilson. Also present John Waldron, highway commissioner, Joe Steinhauer, security, Todd Fleming, sewer system operations attorney, and Tim Fleming, township attorney.

Supervisor Donovan directed Clerk Jacknewitz to read the minutes of the previous meeting. A motion was made by Mr. Lemansky, second by Mr. Green to dispense with the reading of the minutes, and motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Gough, second by Ms. Donovan to approve the minutes of the previous meeting with the following roll call vote: Lemansky - aye, Gough - aye, Green - aye, Wilson - aye, and Donovan - aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

The following bills were approved for payment upon a motion by Mr. Wilson, second by Mr. Green with the following roll call vote: Lemansky - aye, Gough - aye, Green - aye, Wilson - aye, and Donovan - aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

Highway Commissioner Waldron had a meeting this week with the Charles E. Mahoney Company to discuss the Milburn School Road Pavement Overlay Project.

There being no further business to come before the Board, a motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Gough, second by Mr. Green, and motion carried.
