

JANUARY 10, 2023

TOWN BOARD MEETING / ZOOM CONFERENCE

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees of Caseyville Township was called to order at 6 p.m. by Supervisor Krummrich who directed Clerk Gough to call the roll, and upon roll call the following members answered present: Trustees Green, Scott, Gibbs, and Lowry. Also present John Waldron, highway commissioner, Todd Fleming, sewer system operations attorney, Robert Byrum Jr, Joyce Byrum, Robert Byrum III, and Terry Williams, residents.

Supervisor Krummrich directed Clerk Gough to read the minutes of the previous meeting. A motion was made by Mr. Green, second by Ms. Scott to dispense with the reading of the minutes with the following roll call vote: Green – aye, Scott – aye, Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

A motion was made by Mr. Gibbs, second by Mr. Lowry to approve the minutes of the previous meeting with the following roll call vote: Scott – aye, Green – aye, Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

A motion was made by Mr. Lowry, second by Ms. Scott to approve payment for the following bills with the following roll call vote: Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, Scott – aye, Green – aye, Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

A motion was made by Mr. Lowry, second by Mr. Green to go out for bids for the ballfield diamond lights replacement project with the following roll call vote: Scott – aye, Green – aye, Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

Robert Byrum Jr. 106 Primrose Lane and Terry Williams 104 Primrose Lane came before the Board to discuss a sewer back-up problem at their residences.

A motion was made by Mr. Lowry, second by Mr. Green to go into executive session with the following roll call vote: Green – aye, Scott – aye, Lowry – aye, Gibbs – aye, Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

A motion was made by Mr. Green, second by Mr. Gibbs to go back to the regular session with the following roll call vote: Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, Scott – aye, Green – aye, Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

Highway Commissioner Waldron spoke before the Board with the following information:

The road crew has been picking up trash along township road easements, routine maintenance was done in the shop, repaired the spreader, snow event update, replaced culverts, will be doing repairs on Old Collinsville Road next week, fixed potholes, tree limb removal and the large item pick up will held on Monday, February 6, 2023.

Clerk Gough discussed purchasing new computers for the administration office staff.

There being no further business to come before the Board, a motion to adjourn was made by Ms. Scott, second by Mr. Green with the following roll call vote: Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, Scott – aye, Green – aye, Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.
