TOWN BOARD MEETING / ZOOM CONFERENCE

A motion was made by Mr. Gough, second by Ms. Scott to appoint Trustee Lemansky as Acting Supervisor with the following roll call vote: Gough – aye, Green – aye, Scott – aye. and Lemansky – aye. Motion carried by 4 ayes, and 0 nays.

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees of Caseyville Township was called to order at 6 p.m. by Acting Supervisor Lemansky who directed Clerk Jacknewitz to call the roll, and upon roll call the following members answered present: Trustees Gough, Green, and Scott. Also present John Waldron, highway commissioner, Todd Fleming, sewer system operations attorney, Tim Fleming, attorney, Randy Pierce, reporter, Ken Sharkey, James Krummrich, Jackie Krummrich, and Chris Kolker.

A motion was made by Mr. Lemansky, second by Mr. Gough to appoint James Krummrich as Supervisor with the following roll call vote: Lemansky – aye, Gough – aye, Green – aye, and Scott – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 4 aye, and 0 nays.

Upon being sworn in as Caseyville Township Supervisor by Judicial Court Judge Chris Kolker Supervisor Krummrich directed Clerk Jacknewitz to read the minutes of the previous meeting. A motion was made by Mr. Green, second by Mr. Gough to dispense with the reading of the minutes with the following roll call vote: Lemansky – aye, Gough – aye, Green – aye, Scott – aye, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.



The next meeting will be held on Thursday, November 12, 2020, 6 p.m.


