TOWN BOARD MEETING / ZOOM CONFERENCE

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees of Caseyville Township was called to order at 6 p.m. by Supervisor Krummrich who directed Clerk Gough to call the roll, and upon roll call the following members answered present: Trustees Green, Scott, Gibbs, and Lowry. Also present John Waldron, highway commissioner, Todd Fleming, sewer system operations attorney, and Cary Mathews via zoom.

Supervisor Krummrich directed Clerk Gough to read the minutes of the previous meeting. A motion was made by Mr. Green, second by Mr. Gibbs to dispense with the reading of the minutes with the following roll call vote: Green – aye, Scott – aye, Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

Highway Commissioner Waldron spoke before the Board to discuss the following information: The road crew has been mowing easements, trimming trees, various maintenance tasks, shoulder work on the right-of-way, culvert work, discussed the EPA permit, sewer installation begins today, replaced guard rails, hauled rock to be used for the upcoming oil season, ditched roads.

The Board discussed the 2021-2022 Road District Budget & Levy.


