Highway Commissioner Waldron said the Hunters Landing-Long Branch Lane Overlay Project bid opening will be held on the August 12, 202 town board meeting.

The road crew has been mowing easements, replacing culverts, doing road shoulder repairs, fixed potholes, took the new truck to the shop for repairs, replaced tires on the mowers, preparing roads for the upcoming oil season, the road district building is now hooked up to the sewer, and the large item pick-up will be held on August 2, 2021.

Supervisor Krummrich directed the township attorneys to advise the township officials concerning the employees status.

There being no further business to come before the Board, a motion to adjourn was made by Ms. Scott, second by Mr. Green with the following roll call vote: Scott – aye, Green – aye, Lowry – aye, Gibbs – aye, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.
