

OCTOBER 14, 2021

TOWN BOARD MEETING / ZOOM CONFERENCE

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees of Caseyville Township was called to order at 6 p.m. by Supervisor Krummrich who directed Clerk Gough to call the roll, and upon roll call the following members answered present: Trustees Scott, Lowry; excused Green and Gibbs. Also present John Waldron, highway commissioner, Todd Fleming, sewer system operations attorney, Tim Fleming, attorney.

Supervisor Krummrich directed Clerk Gough to read the minutes of the previous meeting. A motion was made by Ms. Scott, second by Mr. Lowry to dispense with the reading of the minutes with the following roll call vote: Scott – aye, Lowry – aye, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 3 ayes, 2 absent, and 0 nays.

Supervisor Krummrich reported to the Board the final walk-thru for the administration building main level restroom project is complete and the tentative date to hold activities and rentals for the public will be slated for November 2021.

Highway Commissioner Waldron spoke before the Board with the following information: The road crew has been busy trimming tree branches on easements, cleaning culverts, graded roads after sewer installation, rocked road shoulders, cold patched roads, roadway sign maintenance, Pausch Road maintenance, truck maintenance, fixed guardrail damage on Hollywood Heights Road, and disposed forty-one tires at Shiloh Valley.

Large trash pickup will be held on Monday, November 1, 2021.

There being no further business to come before the Board, a motion to adjourn was made by Ms. Scott, second by Mr. Krummrich, and motion carried.
