

DECEMBER 9, 2021

TOWN BOARD MEETING / ZOOM CONFERENCE

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees of Caseyville Township was called to order at 6 p.m. by Supervisor Krummrich who directed Clerk Gough to call the roll, and upon roll call the following members answered present: Trustees Green, Lowry, Gibbs; excused Scott, and excused Waldron, highway commissioner. Also present Todd Fleming, sewer system operations attorney, and Tim Fleming, township attorney.

Supervisor Krummrich directed Clerk Gough to read the minutes of the previous meeting. A motion was made by Mr. Green, second by Mr. Gibbs to dispense with the reading of the minutes with the following roll call vote: Green – aye, Lowry – aye, Gibbs – aye, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 4 ayes, 0 nays, 1 absent.

A motion was made by Mr. Gibbs, second by Mr. Lowry to approve the minutes of the previous meeting with the following roll call vote: Lowry – aye, Gibbs – aye, Green – aye, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 4 ayes, 0 nays, 1 absent.

A motion was made by Mr. Krummrich, second by Mr. Green to approve payment for the following bills with the following roll call vote: Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, Green – aye, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 4 ayes, 0 nays, 1 absent.

Supervisor Krummrich informed the Board, the Terry Sabo retirement party was held on December 8, 2021 in celebration of 44 years of exemplary sewer system employment.

The Board discussed obtaining general insurance for the Caseyville Township Sewer System from Steck-Cooper Company.

Trustee Green discussed the details in obtaining a grant for the Khoury League ball diamonds lighting project.


