

APRIL 14, 2022

TOWN BOARD MEETING / ZOOM CONFERENCE

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees of Caseyville Township was called to order at 6 p.m. by Supervisor Krummrich who directed Clerk Gough to call the roll, and upon roll call the following members answered present: Trustees Green, Scott, Gibbs, and Lowry. Also present John Waldron, highway commissioner, Todd Fleming, sewer system operations attorney, and Tim Fleming, township attorney.

Supervisor Krummrich directed Clerk Gough to read the minutes of the previous meeting. A motion was made by Mr. Green, second by Ms. Scott to dispense with the reading of the minutes with the following roll call vote: Green – aye, Scott – aye, Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

A motion was made by Mr. Gibbs, second by Mr. Lowry to approve the minutes of the previous meeting with the following roll call vote: Lowry – aye, Green – aye, Gibbs – aye, Scott -aye, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

A motion was made by Ms. Scott, second by Mr. Green to approve payment for the following bills with the following roll call vote: Lowry – aye, Gibbs – aye, Green – aye, Scott – aye, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

Supervisor Krummrich informed the Board, Martin Roofing will repair the administration building roof leaks in the amount of \$6,648.00.

An agreement was reached to remove the Khoury League ball field lights.

The Athletics ball team has been using the township ball fields.

Attorney Todd Fleming addressed questions concerning the Zip Recruiter job posting for the open township position.

Highway Commissioner Waldron spoke before the Board with the following information:

The road crew is getting the mowers ready for the upcoming mowing season, repaired the street sweeper, checked for damaged culverts, trimmed trees along the road easements, working on drainage projects, hauling rocks, doing road shoulder repairs, the road district main building roof needs to be repaired or replaced due to roof leaking, looking into purchasing a tandem dump truck at an auction on May 10, 2022.

Large trash pick-up will be held on Monday, May 2, 2022.



A motion was made by Mr. Green, second by Ms. Scott to change the outdoor Khoury League sign to read - Caseyville Township Recreation Complex with the following roll call vote: Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, Green – aye, Scott – aye, Krummrich – aye.
