TOWN BOARD MEETING / ZOOM CONFERENCE

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees of Caseyville Township was called to order at 6 p.m. by Supervisor Krummrich who directed Clerk Gough to call the roll, and upon roll call the following members answered present: Trustees Scott, Lowry, Gibbs; excused Green. Also present John Waldron, highway commissioner, Todd Fleming, sewer system operations attorney, and Tim Fleming, township attorney.

Supervisor Krummrich directed Clerk Gough to read the minutes of the previous meeting. A motion was made by Mr. Gibbs, second by Ms. Scott to dispense with the reading of the minutes with the following roll call vote: Gibbs – aye, Scott – aye, Lowry – aye; absent Green, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 4 ayes, 1 absent, 0 nays.

A motion was made by Ms. Scott, second by Mr. Krummrich to approve the minutes of the previous meeting with the following roll call vote: Scott – aye, Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye; absent Green, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote 4 ayes, 1 absent, and 0 nays.

A motion was made by Mr. Lowry, second by Mr. Gibbs to approve payment for the following bills with the following roll call vote: Scott – aye, Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye; absent Green, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 4 ayes, 1 absent, and 0 nays.

Supervisor Krummrich informed the Board the Township has received resumes for the two township open job positions. The committee meeting for union negotiations has been delayed. Also, the power and water has been restored at the township ball diamonds.

Highway Commissioner Waldron spoke before the Board with the following information: The road crew has been mowing along the township roadway easements. The Bethel Road Asphalt Project contracted by Gleeson Asphalt Inc. is complete. The road crew has been working on culvert projects, tree trimming and removal, drainage work, hauled rock, pothole patching, and road shoulder repairs. Also, the bid to buy the tandem dump truck on Tuesday was not successful.

The Board discussed the Township 2022-2023 Budget and Levy, and the Road District 2022-2023 Budget and Levy.

There being no further business to come before the Board, a motion to adjourn was made by Ms. Scott, second by Mr. Gibbs, and motion carried.
