

JUNE 9, 2022

TOWN BOARD MEETING / ZOOM CONFERENCE

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees of Caseyville Township was called to order at 6 p.m. by Supervisor Krummrich who directed Todd Fleming, appointed as acting clerk to call the roll, and upon roll call the following members answered present: Trustees Gibbs, Green, Scott, and Lowry; excused Gough, town clerk, and Waldron, highway commissioner.

Supervisor Krummrich directed Acting Clerk Fleming to read the minutes of the previous meeting. A motion was made by Mr. Green, second by Ms. Scott to dispense with the reading of the minutes with the following roll call vote: Gibbs – aye, Scott – aye, Lowry – aye, Green – aye, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

A motion was made by Mr. Gibbs, second by Mr. Lowry to approve the minutes of the previous meeting with the following roll call vote: Scott – aye, Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, Green – aye, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

A motion was made by Mr. Lowry, second by Mr. Gibbs to approve payment for the following bills with the following roll call vote: Scott – aye, Green – aye, Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

Supervisor Krummrich updated the Board concerning the progress of the township union negotiations, discussed the upcoming Juneteenth federal holiday, and several candidates were interviewed for the open administration secretarial position. Also, the Board discussed the possibility of purchasing a new Gator with upgrades for the administration building property.

Unfinished Business – Town

A motion was made by Mr. Green, second by Mr. Lowry to approve the Township Budget and Appropriation Ordinance #2022-1 with the following roll call vote: Gibbs – aye, Scott – aye, Lowry – aye, Green – aye, and Krummrich – aye.
Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

A motion was made by Mr. Gibbs, second by Mr. Green to approve the Township Tax-Levy Ordinance #2022-2 with the following roll call vote: Lowry – aye, Gibbs – aye, Green – aye, Scott – aye, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

A motion was made by Mr. Krummrich, second by Mr. Green to approve the Road District Budget and Appropriation Ordinance #2022-1 with the following roll call vote: Scott – aye, Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, Green – aye, and Krummrich – aye.

Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

A motion was made by Ms. Scott, second by Mr. Lowry to approve the Road District Tax-Levy Ordinance #2022-2 with the following roll call vote: Scott – aye, Lowry – aye, Gibbs – aye, Green – aye, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

A motion was made by Mr. Gibbs, second by Ms. Scott to approve Resolution #2022-1 to abate the Permanent Road tax in the amount of \$570,000.00 with the following roll call vote: Green – aye, Scott – aye, Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, and Krummrich – aye.

Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

There being no further business to come before the Board, a motion to adjourn was made by Ms. Scott, second by Mr. Green with the following roll call vote: Scott – aye, Green – aye, Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.
