

JULY 14, 2022

TOWN BOARD MEETING / ZOOM CONFERENCE

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees of Caseyville Township was called to order at 6 p.m. by Supervisor Krummrich who directed Clerk Gough to call the roll, and upon roll call the following members answered present: Trustees Green, Scott, Gibbs, and Lowry. Also present John Waldron, highway commissioner, and Todd Fleming, sewer system operations attorney.

Supervisor Krummrich directed Clerk Gough to read the minutes of the previous meeting. A motion was made by Mr. Green, second by Ms. Scott to dispense with the reading of the minutes with the following roll call vote: Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, Scott – aye, Green – aye, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

A motion was made by Mr. Gibbs, second by Mr. Lowry to approve the minutes of the previous meeting with the following roll call vote: Green – aye, Scott – aye, Lowry – aye, Gibbs – aye, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

Clerk Gough informed the Board there were no bills to be paid at this Town Board meeting.

Supervisor Report:

Supervisor Krummrich updated the Board concerning the union contract meeting held on July 13, 2022, with both sides working together on contract details.

The township received a \$109.00 credit for signs, and will apply the credit toward new walking trail signs.

Received a letter from Jennifer Gomric Minton – St. Clair County Assessor concerning the 2022 tax year – multiplier township assessment information.

The IL Township Officials meeting will be held on August 9, 2022 in East Alton, IL.

Tyson Chicken is holding an event on July 22, 2022 announcing the expansion of their plant.

C & K Heating and Cooling have submitted a HVAC maintenance bid of \$1,100.00 for bi-yearly inspections and maintenance. Trustee Gibbs suggested tabling the proposal until further information is available.

Clerk Report:

Clerk Gough addressed the Board concerning a FOIA request from the Belleville News-Democrat. The salary information was provided to the newspaper reporter as requested.

Highway Commissioner Waldron spoke before the Board with the following information:

The road crew is in the middle of the mowing season, in-house repairs were made on various machinery, culvert projects, sprayed weeds along the township roads, worked on drainage projects, road shoulder repairs, replaced guardrails, repaired black top on township roads.

Attorney Todd Fleming touched base with the Board and discussed the union contract negotiations. He called for a motion to table the discussion and approval of the union contract.



Attorney Todd Fleming informed the Board, the State of Illinois has changed the bid minimum requirement for going out for bids from \$20,000.00 to \$30,000.00.

There being no further business to come before the Board, a motion to adjourn was made by Ms. Scott, second by Mr. Green with the following roll call vote: Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, Scott – aye, Green – aye, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.
