TOWN BOARD MEETING / ZOOM CONFERENCE

A motion was made by Ms. Scott, second by Mr. Green to approve the nomination of Todd Fleming, attorney as acting clerk with the following roll call vote: Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, Scott – aye, Green – aye, Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

The regular semi-monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Caseyville Township Sewer System was called to order at 6 p.m. by Supervisor Krummrich who directed Acting Clerk Fleming to call the roll, and upon roll call the following members answered present: Trustees Green – aye, Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, Scott – aye, Krummrich – aye; excused Clerk Gough. Also present John Waldron, highway commissioner.

Supervisor Krummrich directed Acting Clerk Fleming to read the minutes of the previous meeting. Road & Bridge Fund:	7,215.33


Supervisor Krummrich updated the Board concerning the approval of a 30 thousand dollar grant from the St. Clair County Grants Department. Discussed Bethel Ridge Farm annexation to the City of O'Fallon, IL. Purchased new chairs for the annex building. Discussed a right-of-way issue. Discussed the state of repairs on the township ballfield outbuildings, and discussed connecting a new water line for the concession stand. Also, for three days the road district crew assisted the Village of Caseyville with disposing of fallen trees.

A motion was made by Ms. Scott, second by Mr. Green to waive the sewer disconnection fee for the former ice rink located in Fairview Heights with the following roll call vote: Lowry – aye, Scott – aye, Gibbs – aye, Green – abstain, Krummrich – abstain. Motion carried by a vote of 3 ayes, 2 abstain, 0 nays.

There being no further business to come before the Board, a motion to adjourn was made by Ms. Scott, second by Mr. Green with the following roll call vote: Scott – aye, Green – aye, Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.
