

OCTOBER 13, 2022

TOWN BOARD MEETING / ZOOM CONFERENCE

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees of Caseyville Township was called to order at 6 p.m. by Supervisor Krummrich who directed Clerk Gough to call the roll, and upon roll call the following members answered present: Trustees Green, Scott, Gibbs, and Lowry. Also present John Waldron, highway commissioner, and Todd Fleming, sewer system operations attorney.

Supervisor Krummrich directed Clerk Gough to read the minutes of the previous meeting. A motion was made by Mr. Green, second by Mr. Lowry to dispense with the reading of the minutes with the following roll call vote: Scott – aye, Lowry – aye, Gibbs – aye, Green – aye, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

A motion was made by Ms. Scott, second by Mr. Gibbs to approve the minutes of the previous meeting with the following roll call vote: Lowry – aye, Scott – aye, Green – aye, Gibbs – aye, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

A motion was made by Mr. Gibbs, second by Mr. Lowry to approve payment for the following bills with the following roll call vote: Scott – aye, Green – aye, Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

Supervisor Krummrich spoke before the Board with the following information:

The township hosted a luncheon for the country western band this week to celebrate the last dance of the year. We hope to have an update on replacing the township ball field lights soon. Four teams are interested in renting the township ball field facilities next year.

Highway Commissioner Waldron spoke before the Board with the following information:

The road crew has been mowing along roadway easements, cleaned out culverts, worked on the road district vehicles, attended the road commissioner meeting this week, removed trees along roadway easements, did some minor building improvements, new vehicles are two years out for purchasing, road crew will vacuum roadway leaves in a few weeks, looking into drainage improvement projects, cleaning out ditches and doing road shoulder repairs.

A motion was made by Mr. Gibbs, second by Ms. Scott to approve the clerical union contract with the following roll call vote: Lowry – aye, Gibbs – aye, Scott – aye, Green – aye, and Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.


