TOWN BOARD MEETING / ZOOM CONFERENCE

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees of Caseyville Township was called to order at 6 p.m. by Supervisor Krummrich who directed Clerk Gough to call the roll, and upon roll call the following members answered present: Trustees Green, Scott, Gibbs; excused Lowry. Also present John Waldron, highway commissioner, Todd Fleming, sewer system operations attorney.

Supervisor Krummrich directed Clerk Gough to read the minutes of the previous meeting. A motion was made by Mr. Green, second by Ms. Scott to dispense with the reading of the minutes with the following roll call vote: Green – aye, Scott – aye, Gibbs – aye, Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 4 ayes, 0 nays, 1 absent.

Supervisor Krummrich spoke before the Board with the following information:

The Supervisor met with the auditors today and the auditors said there were no sufficient issues found in the audit.

The Supervisor spoke with the City of O'Fallon Mayor Roach concerning eliminating a ballfield water meter and adding a new water line.


Highway Commissioner Waldron spoke before the Board with the following information:

The road crew has been mowing along township road easements, picked up downed trees, there was a fatal accident that occurred on Bethel Mine Road, attended the quarterly EPA stormwater meeting, picked up tree limbs along road easements after the last storm, sprayed weeds along road easements, patched pot holes, worked on damaged culverts, hauled rock, and replaced road signs in the township areas.
