

DECEMBER 14, 2023

TOWN BOARD MEETING / ZOOM CONFERENCE

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees of Caseyville Township was called to order at 6 p.m. by Supervisor Krummrich who directed Clerk Gough to call the roll, and upon roll call the following members answered present: Trustees Green, Scott, Gibbs, and Lowry. Also present John Waldron, highway commissioner, Todd Fleming, sewer system operations attorney, Andrew Allen, Steck and Cooper Insurance representative.

Supervisor Krummrich directed Clerk Gough to read the minutes of the previous meeting. A motion was made by Mr. Green, second by Ms. Scott to dispense with the reading of the minutes with the following roll call vote: Green – aye, Scott – aye, Lowry – aye, Gibbs – aye, Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

Andrew Allen, Steck and Cooper Insurance representative gave a presentation to the Board concerning a public entity insurance proposal for the township.

Supervisor Krummrich spoke before the Board with the following information:

Discussed a recent FOIA request concerning the township's software service providers.

Caseyville Township has been awarded a St. Clair County Grant in the amount of \$50,000 for lights, and \$25,600 toward constructing pavilions at the township recreation complex.

Piping has been purchased to solve some ballfield drainage problems.

Discussed possibly installing a ballfield drinking water fountain, and also keeping a porta-potty permanently on the walking trail.

Supervisor Krummrich discussed recognizing a township senior volunteer, and to receive board approval to present the volunteer with a gift card in appreciation of her hard work.


Highway Commissioner Waldron spoke before the Board with the following information:

The road crew has been vacuuming leaves along the township roadways, ditched along easements, removed trees, removed trash, worked on shop repair jobs, used the chipper, pothole patching, culvert projects, attended an IEPA event, repaired road signs.
