

JANUARY 11, 2024

TOWN BOARD MEETING / ZOOM CONFERENCE

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees of Caseyville Township was called to order at 6 p.m. by Supervisor Krummrich who directed Clerk Gough to call the roll, and upon roll call the following members answered present: Trustees Green, Scott, Gibbs, and Lowry. Also present John Waldron, highway commissioner, Todd Fleming, sewer system operations attorney.

Supervisor Krummrich directed Clerk Gough to read the minutes of the previous meeting. A motion was made by Mr. Green, second by Ms. Scott to dispense with the reading of the minutes with the following roll call vote: Green – aye, Scott – aye, Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

A motion was made by Mr. Gibbs, second by Mr. Lowry to approve the minutes of the previous meeting with the following roll call vote: Green – aye, Scott – aye, Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

A motion was made by Mr. Lowry, second by Mr. Krummrich to approve payment for the following bills with the following roll call vote: Green – aye, Scott – aye, Lowry – aye, Gibbs – aye, Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.

Supervisor Krummrich spoke before the Board with the following information:

Discussed having a sewer issue at the administration building. Discovered the backflow flapper rusted off and clogged the sewer line.

The AARP tax preparation service will begin the first week of February.

The Supervisor met with Attorney Fleming to discuss the bidding process for two upcoming Caseyville Township Recreation Complex grants.

Trustee Lowry informed the Board the township should work with Local 90 to donate their time toward doing concrete work for the recreation complex.

A motion was made by Mr. Lowry, second by Mr. Gibbs to go into executive session to discuss the open Sewer Plant Supervisor position. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Ms. Scott, second by Mr. Green to return to the regular township meeting session. Motion carried unanimously.

Highway Commissioner Waldron spoke before the Board with the following information:

The road crew ditched along roadways, removed trees and brush along township easements, installed rip rap along ditches to prevent erosion, shop repairs, picked up and chipped Christmas trees from drop off sites, patched potholes, culvert replacement projects, replaced damaged township roadway signs.

The next large trash pick-up will be held on Monday, February 5, 2024.

There being no further business to come before the Board, a motion to adjourn was made by Ms. Scott, second by Mr. Green with the following roll call vote: Green – aye, Scott – aye, Gibbs – aye, Lowry – aye, Krummrich – aye. Motion carried by a vote of 5 ayes, and 0 nays.
